The Manhattan Psychiatric Center has existed in some form since 1848. The facility and Wards Island on which it sits served as the point of entry for the world's immigrants until 1892, when that duty was reassigned to Ellis Island.

Today the Manhattan Psychiatric Center performs the full range of health services for adults with mental illness. In addition, the facility has special quarters reserved for the criminally insane, as well as those requiring treatment for radiation poisoning.
